All 4 of our Installed Masters' Associations held their Annual General Meeting and at least one social event with their Ladies.

Our Provincial Charity, The Cleeves & Whitehead Trust held its Annual Holiday at Lytham St Annes, its usual 2 Almoners Lunches and provided much needed support for many Brethren and Ladies of our Province.

And we advanced over 40 Candidates into our Mark Lodges. I thank everyone involved for Marking so well and for bringing us up-to-date after the horrors of the previous two years.

During the coming year, our Order will be focussing on Recruitment and Retention. Our membership comes entirely from the Craft, so firstly it is imperative that we vigorously support our own Craft Lodges and Chapters. Then, with the Craft's current membership drive and our own 'Magic of the Mark' initiative, we should see our memberships begin to grow again. If you have not yet seen the 'Magic of the Mark' video, I must simply ask you – why not? It's on the Provincial website, it's been extremely well publicised and it's recently been shown to representatives of all your Mark Lodges. Lodges were given posters, promotional leaflets and business card—size handouts for you to give to your colleagues in the Craft. All of these contain a QR code which takes the recipient to the video which they can then view in their own time on their smartphones. Please make use of all these tools, Brethren, over the coming months.

#### PROVINCIAL REGISTRAR'S REPORT

W.Bro. Gary Parker, Provincial Grand Secretary, read the following submitted report on behalf of V.W.Bro. John Morgan, the Provincial Grand Registrar:

Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master and Brethren, at 31st August 2022 the total membership of our Mark Lodges was 1065 compared to 1047 twelve months previously. The number of our Brethren holding dual membership increased to 103. The actual number of Mark Masons in the Province at 31st August 2022 was 962.

New Members were	88 against	6 in the previous year
Resignations were	44 against	42
Exclusions	2 against	1
and Deaths	24 against	32

There were 41 Advancements during the year and the number of Joining Members 47.

In respect of our Royal Ark Mariner Lodges:

During the year there were 12 Elevations and 15 Joining Members including 11 Brethren who joined The Carl Whitehead Lodge of Installed Commanders. However, we suffered 12 deaths and 19 resignations. At 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022 the total membership was 638 compared to 642 twelve months previously. The number of Brethren holding dual membership increased by 3 to 203. The actual number of Royal Ark Mariner Masons in the Province at 31st August 2022 was 435.

#### ANNUAL CHAIRMAN OF THE TRUSTEES REPORT 2023

Brother President, Ladies and Brethren, this report covers from the period the 5<sup>th</sup> March 2022 to the 4<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

The difficulties created by the pandemic seem to be over, although I still hear of many cases of people catching Covid including my own son last week. Due to the improvement in the situation, it has allowed the Trust to perform its normal duties of looking after our members who need pastoral care.

Unfortunately, the Trust has not been without its own difficulties as we have had our Provincial Almoner off with serious illness for most of the year. Fortunately, as some of you may remember, we appointed an Assistant Almoner, W.Bro, John Gray, last year who, with the assistance of W.Bro. Alex Steele, held the fort and continued to support our members who were in need. I am pleased to welcome back today our Provincial Almoner, who is now making a wonderful recovery.

During the accounting period from the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 to the 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022 grants in the sum of £49,640 were made to our members compared with the same period the previous year which was £39,921. This is a 24% increase on the previous year.

The MBF received donations of £97,856 from the Trust which is basically money donated by our members who have now achieved an honorific level. We still have an annual deficit but it is hoped that when the Festival reaches its conclusion monies which have been going to the Festival from members and Lodges will start to return to the Cleeves and Whitehead Trust and enable us to continue our work.

Our Almoners Lunches have now returned to normal and the next lunch will be held on April 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Cedar Court Hotel, Ainley Top, Huddersfield.

The annual holiday at Lytham St Annes will take place on the 14<sup>th</sup> May this year and we also continue to assist those who cannot attend this holiday due to health problems by providing a private respite care break.

I would like to thank the Trustees and Officers associated with the Trust and the Magnificent Seven who continue to give their tireless support year in and out especially our Secretary W.Bro. Jim Reynolds who is the mainstay of our Trust, organising the holiday amongst his other work. And also W.Bro. Tony Hobson who organises the excellent Almoners Lunches.

We now have two Trustees who are stepping down having completed their nine-year tenure. They are W.Bro. Alan Pendleton and W.Bro. David Hymas. Although I should not single anybody out as they have both given tremendous service to the Trust, I have to say that David Hymas's expertise as a solicitor has been outstanding in assisting us in bringing the Trust up-to-date.

One of these vacancies is being filled by our Treasurer, Philip Oldfield, who will become a Trustee as well as maintaining his position as Treasurer.

Our scouts are still looking for someone who has the necessary skills to support the Trust and join our team.

Finally, my sincere thanks go to all of you Brethren for the much-valued support that you give the Trust.

That, Brother President, concludes the Annual Report for the Cleeves and Whitehead Trust.
