

From the Royal Arch. **Philip Drury** 3<sup>rd</sup> Provincial Grand Principal, and **Gerald Wilde** Past Deputy Grand Superintendent.

From the Allied Masonic Degree, we have the District Grand Prefect, **Brian Butterfield**, and **Brian Price**, Past Deputy Grand Master, **Sam Carris** Past Deputy District Grand Prefect, and **Gerry Barker** (and Gerry is also a Past Deputy District Grand Master in Royal & Select, Grand Preceptor in St Thomas of Acon, and Deputy Master Mason in the Operatives.) From the Royal and Select Masters, we have **lan Cotton** Deputy District Grand Master, **Algis Vasis**, District Grand Principal Conductor of the Works. **Ron Murtagh**, Past Deputy District Grand Master, and From the Ancient and Accepted Rite, we have lan Smith Inspector General.

Brethren, if I have missed anyone, I do apologise. Brethren I think all our guests now deserve our applause.

Brethren, you have all received the Provincial Grand Secretaries Report, in which he takes a retrospective look at what was a very busy period since our last Provincial Grand Lodge meeting.

The purpose of my address is to endeavour to set the scene for the new Provincial year ahead.

We have been fortunate in our Province to have had many distinguished Brethren as our Provincial Grand Master. One such person being Right Worshipful Brother James Bramley Morley whom many of you will remember well. He served from 1989 to 1994. During his time in office, he successfully established the four Installed Masters Associations which are totally unique within our order.

The Installed Masters' Associations provide a unique bond between Mark Masons and strengthen the link between the Province, its Lodges and their membership. Their purpose is to promote friendship, harmony and inter-visiting between all Mark Master Masons, primarily within Mark Lodges affiliated to each Association.

Over recent years social and fund-raising events have been driven by the efforts of the Installed Masters Associations and because of this it became apparent that the use of the words Installed Masters was becoming a barrier to the involvement of all of our membership. Often those below the chair were under the impression that the Installed Masters Association was not something they could get involved with.

I can now announce that following discussions with all the Associations and with unanimous agreement the name of all four of our Associations will be changed to indicate that they are fully inclusive and open to all our members. Each Association will formally adopt the name change at their next Annual General Meeting, although I see that the Associations have already started to adopt the name change, for example:-

The L&DIMA to be The Leeds and District Association of Mark Master Masons. With the others following the same name on convention.

Brethren this is a positive step in the right direction, and I hope that you will all get involved and support the Association to which your Lodge is affiliated.

Last year I proposed to further improve the experience for newly advanced Brethren, I would like to see all Grand Lodge Certificates Presented at special Grand Lodge Certificate Presentation Evenings organised by the Associations.

Brethren, the purpose of the Grand Lodge Certificate Presentation Evenings is to create a special event. We all know that if we have an event with goodly numbers, we create a special atmosphere, the Magic of the Mark becomes evident, and everyone gets their spirits lifted by the experience. However, our discussions with the Association Executives concluded that there was absolutely no reason to prevent Lodges presenting Grand Lodge Certificates as part of their own Lodge business, if they prefer. So, with unanimous agreement amongst the Associations Grand Lodge Certificate Presentation Evenings will start later this year, in fact I believe that one of the Associations has already booked such an evening of which there will be 15 Brethren in attendance hopefully with support from members of their own Lodges, including the Masters, Proposers and Seconders.

Brethren I think we should now give them our applause.

Brethren, I would like to turn your attention to our very own charity, The Cleeves and Whitehead Trust. Our aim is to strengthen it and bring it back to at least Pre Festival levels, so I am delighted to be able to report as follows.

Over the last twelve months the trustees of the Cleeves and Whitehead Trust have been working to bring the administration of the charity up to date. In addition, the Trustees have reviewed their obligation under the GDPR regulations concluding... that the frequent requests from Lodge Charity Stewards, for data to be available to support them in their work, will soon be available, providing that certain safeguards are put in place. All Lodge charity Stewards, Provincial Charity Advisors (Rep's) and all others who may need to be party to the Trust's data must sign a declaration of confidentiality before receiving any of the data.

At the recent Provincial Charity Committee Meeting Lodge Charity Stewards were updated on the way the newly introduced systems will help them to encourage members to contribute effectively to the Trust, and will also provide individual members of the Province, with a personal annual statement as to their status with regards to their regular contributions to the Trust. It will also show their current MBF Honorific levels. Brethren Charity giving, and Benevolence is slowly pushing its way forward throughout Mark Masonry and we should be proud of our own Province, the number of our petitioners relieved in 2024 was 242, the total amount given to petitioners in one form or another in 2024 was £58,000

The Provincial Charity Rep's (the Magnificent Seven) played a major part in supporting our lodge Charity Stewards in the past, moving forward there will now be ten Charity Advisors who will have a set number of Lodges to visit on a regular basis (not just Installation nights) which will enable closer communications with the Brethren, with Charity updates. Those Brethren are: - W.Bro's. Alex Baskeyfield, Christian Holmes, Keith Morrison, Richard Stone, Richard Morley, Grahame Littlewood, John Bulliman, David Hedley Todd, Steven Spooner, and John Fitzpatrick.

The Provincial Charity Advisors will no longer routinely attend at your installation meeting so on that night the Toast to the Cleeves and Whitehead Trust will become a formal Toast only. However, the Charity Advisors will be expected to attend your Lodge Scroll Night where they will be available to address the meeting on charitable matters should it be so desired and also address the Brethren following an informal toast to the Cleeves and Whitehead Trust at the festive board.

This is a tremendous leap forward in enabling the Trustees to manage the trust more effectively, keeping the members of our Province more engaged in the Trust's work. All members of the Province will shortly be receiving a Newsletter from the Trust, which is planned to become a biannual publication. In addition, an up-to-date statement of individuals' contributions to the Trust will also be issued.

I fully support the Trustees in this ongoing transformation of the Trust which will improve communications by the Trustees, coupled with the changes which will support our new Provincial Charity Advisors, bringing new vigour to our fund-raising activities throughout this Province.

Continuing on a charitable note, Most Worshipful Brother Pro Grand Master I would like to present you with this donation of £9510.00 for the Grand Masters Keystone Fund which is in addition to the £30,087.00 which is going to the MBF for the honorifics our Brethren have achieved.

Brethren, I said that we have to set out a plan for the future of our Province which will see its continued growth and create an environment which will put a smile back on everyone's face as we enjoy our Mark Masonry together, I believe we have started that plan in good form but we must strive to improve and continue to expand what we have accomplished so far.

Finally, Brethren, I thank you all for your magnificent support at today's meeting. I look forward to seeing you all again in the future, and of course shortly for Luncheon at the Midland Hotel.
