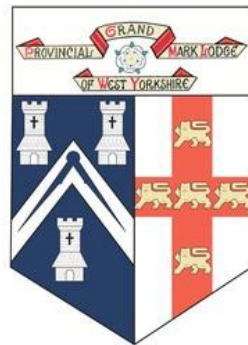

Brethren, you have all received the Provincial Grand Secretary's Report, in which he has taken a retrospective look at what has been a very busy period since our last Provincial Grand Lodge meeting.

As I said in my address last year, the purpose of my address is to endeavour to set the scene for the new Provincial year ahead, what we have achieved during 2025 and where we now stand. Over the past year, we have seen significant changes and progress within the Province and I firmly believe that we have established a strong and effective working team.

Our aim was and remains, to support all the Lodges within our Province, and with a team of four Rulers, it was an easy decision to divide the Province into four sections, aligned with our Mark Associations, Each Ruler was allocated responsibility for Lodges in a Mark Association area for a period of six months, after which we rotate. Having looked back over the year we agreed that six months was too long for one period, so we are changing it to three months. This new approach will, I believe, further strengthen our engagement and visibility across the Province.

I am particularly pleased to report that our advancements continue to increase. Since April last year, we have advanced, new Brethren into the Mark Degree, and this success is entirely due to you Brethren, and the work you do within your Lodges.

Advancements were only one of the changes introduced as part of our 2025 programme. On 10th July, we launched our first Grand Lodge Certificate Presentation Evening, held at the Greenhead Masonic Hall in Huddersfield. This event was attended by over 20 newly Advanced Brethren, who were supported together with members of their individual Lodges.

The second Certificate Presentation Evening was held on 25th March at the Masonic Hall Wetherby. Brethren, the purpose of these Grand Lodge Certificate Presentation Evenings is to create a special and memorable occasion for our newly Advanced Brethren, and I believe that objective is being successfully achieved due to the continued support from the Associations and the officers of the year, the certificate evenings are proving to be a success so we will continue to improve those special events to make them an even more enjoyable evening throughout Province.

Our Provincial Grand Stewards Lodge is now giving more support across the Province and today is a prime example, and I thank all the Stewards who are helping us here today, but not just today, there is now a much stronger support at both the advancement meetings and Provincial escorted visits throughout the year, the Lodge is steadily growing in numbers and in strength, the early promotions for active Brethren within the Provincial Grand Stewards Lodge have now started to filter through the system, and I would like to thank the Brethren of the Provincial Grand Stewards Lodge for their continued support.

2026/7 The Magic of the Mark initiative has been a great success within our Province over the past few years, and we are therefore pleased to continue promoting Magic of the Mark evenings throughout the province, the magic of the Mark video is to be updated; to reflect the progress we are making within our Province. Previously, our Mark Lodges have hosted these evenings within their own lodges, with the kind permission and support of the Provincial Grand Master of the Craft, James Henry Newman. We are now delighted to share that he has given his consent for the Mark Degree to approach Craft and Chapter Lodges directly, with a view to holding Magic of the Mark evenings at a regular lodge meeting Brethren, this is yet another demonstration of the bonds and cooperation between our orders.

I congratulate all the brethren who have received honours today, both the Acting officers of the year and those who have received a promotion, Brethren who receive a promotion rank is due to their continued support and commitment to the Mark degree in many forms year after year. And whilst we acknowledge that fact, we cannot forget the Officers of the year and the contribution they make in their year of office. I feel that the office of an acting Warden is a worthy rank to hold, Our Provincial Grand Wardens are two key officers of the year and will from this meeting going forward we are to promote the Wardens with a two year appointment, the Junior Warden will be promoted to the Senior Warden for his second year in office, That in turn will free up a Grand Rank promotion every year.

Brethren, I would like to bring you up to date with the changes made to the Cleeves and Whitehead Trust's during 2025.

The new computer systems and programs are now well embedded and allows the trust to have better internal financial controls. They have also enabled more direct communications with the membership of the Province and support to the Provincial Charity Advisors.

The trustees have now approved a new constitution which was endorsed by the Provincial Charity Committee at its annual meeting in March. The revisions are mainly to update the previous governing document, which was created in 2005. It reflects the development of charity governance over the last twenty years and gives more flexibility on the appointment of new trustees.

I am informed that some £27,000 was sent to the MBF earlier this year to qualify 38 Brethren for various MBF honorifics and included 3 Grand Patron Diamond and 4 Grand Patron Gold, which will be /have been presented this morning.

The C&WT have also supported the following: Almoners Lunches £8,000, Mark Holiday £30,000, Grants £24,000 and Other Charities £22,000 making a total of £84,000.

Also, the trust has now taken over responsibility for the online shop, you will find this on the Provincial Web Site where you can purchase a range of Masonic items as well as regalia, and I would encourage you go online and see what is now available for sale.

Brethren, I said that we have to set out a plan for the future of our Province which will see its continued growth and create an environment which will put a smile back on everyone's face as we enjoy our Mark Masonry together, It takes a Vision to make changes, and changes constitute progress, and Wisdom to foresee our main aim, and Integrity to deliver. I believe with the support of our brethren we have started that plan in good form, but we must continue to improve and expand on what we have accomplished so far.

Finally, Brethren, I thank you all for your magnificent support at today's meeting, and I look forward to seeing you all again in the future, and of course shortly for Luncheon at the Midland Hotel.
